

Foreign Affairs:

- The United States: "biggest, main enemy"; the key obstacle to DPRK development; "no matter who leads the White House, U.S. policy on the DPRK never changes." "If its anti-DPRK policy is withdrawn, the potential for a new U.S.-DPRK relationship exists"
- ROK: "no exaggeration" that inter-Korean relations have "reverted back to before the Panmunjom Declaration was announced. DPRK also blamed ROK for ongoing military modernization efforts and for continuing with joint military exercises.
- China: "the relations with China improved significantly in recent years", with a future goal to prioritize "special" relations with China.

DPRK's Strategic Thinking on China

- Maintaining the traditional relationship.
- Building up the strategic communication.
- China's experience on economic development
- "An unreliable balancer".
- Counterbalancing the US threat in its global level strategy,
